

Iowa Division of Workers' Compensation (IWD DWC) Announcement

Important Reminder: Mandate Date for Iowa EDI Claims Release 3.1 is July 16, 2019 and Trading Partners Transmitting Directly (Direct SFTP) and EDI Vendors must test

Date: May 30, 2019

This is a reminder that the Mandate Date for **Iowa** EDI Claims Release 3.1 is <u>July 16, 2019</u>. Trading Partners stop sending EDI Release 2.0 data as of close of business **July 2, 2019**. Please review the IWD DWC Transition from Release 2 to IAIABC Claims Release 3.1 Timelines Summary, available on the Implementation Info page of the IWD DWC EDI Claims Website: https://iwddwcedi.info/impl-info for more information on these and other important dates.

The period for testing Iowa Claims Release 3.1 started on **April 1, 2019**. FROI and SROI testing should be completed by **June 3, 2019** as indicated in the Transition Timeline Summary.

Trading Partners Transmitting Directly (Direct SFTP) and EDI Vendors are required to complete the Test Plan which can be found at https://iwddwcedi.info/, select Implementation Info. Testers must request testing feedback from Verisk/ISO by submitting the Iowa EDI Testing Feedback Request List R3.1 to iwddwccedi@iso.com.

Exception: No testing is required for IWD DWC Free Web Entry filers.

ATTENTION - Trading Partner Profile Registration for EDI Claims Release 3.1:

If you are already an approved Trading Partner in Iowa for Release 2, you must re-register as a new Trading Partner for Release 3.1. If you have not yet registered for Iowa's EDI Claims Release 3.1, the Trading Partner Registration can be found online at https://iwddwcedi.info/register. Detailed registration instructions on how to complete the online form is available for download on the homepage. Trading Partners and EDI Vendors must review and ensure that Trading Partner Profile for Iowa Release 3.1 matches claims sent in production for Release 3.1, otherwise files may potentially reject due to Sender ID issues, Insurer FEIN or Claim Administrator FEIN/ Postal Code mismatch.
